Mental Health Services Navigator

- → Do you have health insurance that has an affordable, accessible option for mental health services? If yes, consider narrowing down your selection to your preferred counseling point-of-view (i.e. Christian counseling, marriage and family counseling, in person, etc)
- → (or) Do you have an Employee Assistance Program (EAP) that can get you started with (typically six) counseling sessions?
- → (if not) Are you able to use a self-pay option (typically a reduced rate with no insurance being applied).
- → (if not) Where do you live? (or) Are you a parent or do you have children who need these services?
